PRESCHOOL REGISTRATION

Calling all 3-5 year olds! St. James Preschool is currently registering children of St. James parishioners for the 2019-20 school year. Non-parishioner registration will open at a later date. Please call the preschool (812-768-5779), or the elementary school (812-867-2661) for information. You can also email Ms. Deb (dhaake@evdio.org) or just go to the school website www.stjameshaubstadt.com, click on Preschool and Information, print off the registration form and mail it back to the school. Only a \$25 registration fee is needed to hold your child's spot for the school year. St. James offers a two day per week class for three year olds and a three day per week class for four and five year olds. Morning and afternoon classes are available for the three-day program. We also provide before and after school daycare on the days your child attends and daycare on the days they do not attend.

IREAD AND ILEARN TESTING

Our spring testing window for the new ILEARN test is April 23 through May 17. We will not be testing on all of these days, but parents are asked to be aware of the upcoming testing and avoid scheduling appointments on these dates if at all possible. More specific testing dates and times for each grade level will be shared in an upcoming newsletter. The third grade IREAD test will be the week of March 18-22.
