MOMO CHALLENGE

If your child has experienced the online pop-up called the "Momo Challenge", and he/she is disturbed by this, please see these coping strategies from Catholic Charities.

- REMIND children that characters in games or videos are NOT real.
- Reassure them that if they are worried about something they saw, they are not in trouble and adults can help.
- Let them know that scary images or threats should always be reported to their parents or a teacher, if they see it at school. This is the only way adults can help by reporting and making websites take the images down.
- Momo is not the only scary image that they will see on the internet. They may see others and they might read or hear other things that make them worried. Always tell an adult who can help.
- Help friends by not re-sharing threatening information or images. This just makes more friends scared or confused. Tell adults who can help.
- You are safe here at school.
