8TH GRADE PSAT TEST

A representative from Mater Dei High School will be at St. James on Tuesday, Sept. 25, to administer the PSAT 8/9 assessment to our 8th graders. The test will take approximately two hours. The test is given to establish a starting point in terms of college and career readiness as students transition to high school. The exam is divided into three broad categories: math, reading, and writing/ language. Scores are used to assist the Mater Dei guidance office in placement of students in their freshman classes and provides St. James School with data to help align our middle school curriculum to high school. All students will be taking the assessment, regardless of the high school they will be attending, and this is a free assessment. 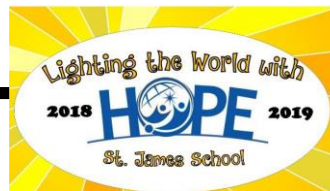
