#### Choice Scholarship

The Indiana Choice Scholarship program provides state funding (resident tax dollars) to qualifying students that is used to offset tuition costs at participating schools.

To qualify for the Indiana Choice Scholarship, students must meet this criteria:

- A student must be a legal resident of Indiana.
- A student must be at least five years old and less than 22 years old by October 1 of the school year that the student is applying.
- The student must be a member of a household with an annual income of not more than 400% of the amount to qualify for the federal free and reduced lunch program.

### St. James Scholarship

St. James will provide opportunities for needs-based parish scholarships to St. James parishioner and deanery families that do not qualify for an Indiana Choice Scholarship. ## Registration and Enrollment Timeline

**January 8th:** Enrollment begins for current students and parishioners

**February 5th:** Enrollment begins for current Sts. Peter and Paul and Holy Cross parishioners

**February 2024:** The Choice application will be shared with school families. To direct Choice Scholarship dollars to St. James or to apply to receive a parish needs-based scholarship, a family must submit this scholarship application to the school.

**February 26th:** Enrollment begins for all families.

**June 2024:** Choice applications are due to the school office.

Families choosing to not submit the scholarship application will be charged full tuition and registration fees.

### Order of enrollment when a grade level is at capacity.

1. Parishioners with current siblings at St. James
2. Parishioners without siblings
3. Deanery students with current K-8th grade siblings (Sts. Peter and Paul, then Holy Cross)
4. Non-parishioner with current K-8th grade siblings
5. Deanery Students without current siblings (Sts. Peter and Paul, then Holy Cross)
6. Non-parishioner without siblings
